Key Responsibilities

- Keeping roadsides and pavements tidy on a regular basis
- Grounds maintenance including weeding, strimming and weed control
- Litter picking and emptying litter and dog waste bins
- Inspecting, cleaning and carrying out minor repairs to parish street furniture (benches, bins, phone box, entrance signs, street name plates, salt-grit bins, bus shelters, etc.)
- Monitoring drainage gullies and reporting blockages
- Taking meter readings
- Winter tasks including clearing designated paths, checking salt/grit levels and spreading salt where required
- Addressing minor highways issues and reporting more serious concerns
- Other ad-hoc duties as directed by the Parish Council
